The University Signs a Cooperation Agreement with the Ministry of Industry to Establish a Factory for Advanced Production and Innovation at the University

His Excellency Prof. Dr. Abdulrahman bin Hamad Al-Dawood, President of the University, and His Excellency the Deputy Minister of Industry and Mineral Resources, Eng. Osama bin Abdulaziz Al-Zamil, signed on Wednesday, 25/11/1444 AH, a cooperation agreement between the Ministry of Industry and Mineral Resources and Qassim University, to establish and build a factory for advanced production and innovation on the lands of the university, in the presence of His Excellency the Vice President of the University, Dr. Muhammad bin Abdulrahman Al-Sawi, His



Excellency the Vice President for Graduate Studies and Scientific Research, Dr. Muhammad bin Fahd Al-Sharekh, and His Excellency the Vice President for Planning and Development Quality Prof. Dr. Khalid bin Bani Al-Harbi, His Excellency the Vice President for Educational Affairs, Dr. Fahd bin Suleiman Al-Ahmad, and a number of deans of the concerned colleges.

This agreement aims to establish a factory for advanced production and innovation at the university, and to train the university's employees, including on-the-job training, as well as stimulate research and development, innovation and invention by encouraging the factory to cooperate with the relevant authorities at the university, as the two parties seek to cooperate in the fields of manufacturing, advanced production and industrial innovation, which are key pillars to contribute to achieving the Kingdom's vision 2030 industrially, and these areas contribute to raising the contribution of the industrial sector to the domestic product, creating jobs, and increasing the volume of non-oil exports. To achieve sustainable development, diversify sources of income, and contribute to improving the competitiveness index and innovation index, by focusing on industry as a strategic choice.

The areas of cooperation between the two parties in accordance with the terms of this agreement include activating the (Rafed program), which is concerned with establishing and building factories for advanced production and innovation on the lands of the university, setting the necessary standards for granting investors industrial licenses to establish industrial projects within the Rafed program, as well as designing incentives and services supporting the program, in addition to setting performance indicators for the program in the cooperation area between the two parties, and training university employees.

This agreement also contributes to stimulating research, development, innovation and invention by encouraging the factory in cooperation with the relevant authorities at the university, benefiting from the experiences of both parties in operating the program, as well as developing academic programs or developing current programs in support of the goal, and working to attract professional and academic partners of experts to transfer experience and enrich the program, and establishing and activating scientific research and innovation plans in the fields of advanced manufacturing, in addition to supporting cooperation and partnership with global partners in the academic and commercial sectors of technology pioneers. Advanced manufacturing through the program, with the study of linking faculty members and graduate students with industrial facilities and houses of expertise to provide studies and support industrial research to improve the efficiency of factory operation and apply advanced manufacturing solutions.

The events also include training courses, seminars and meetings presented by a group of specialists in many fields, with the aim of educating graduates professionally, in addition to presenting effective methods in searching for a job and how to prepare a CV and conduct personal interviews.

During his speech at the opening ceremony, His Highness the Emir of the region praised the university's steps and efforts to employ young people, and open the way for families in the evening period, pointing to the high percentage of lack of jobs suffered by the female element, stressing the importance of the steps taken by the state to empower women from jobs and give them more and more opportunity, stressing the success of this forum, which he considers a duty for every university, and any government facility to establish a career day to localize jobs and share the state's efforts in empowering its children. Al-Daoud explained that the university has employed more than 244 citizens in various disciplines, including teaching assistant, lecturer, faculty members, technicians, administrators and others, since the establishment of the previous career day until today, noting that after a few days the names of applicants for the position of teaching assistant will be announced, and the university will follow this approach, and God willing, we will soon celebrate the achievement of a high percentage of citizens who work in the corridors of this university in the educational and technical field, as for administrative jobs, the university has localization by 100%.
