The university hospital, which was inaugurated among 33 projects from Qassim University, during the royal visit of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz - may God protect him - to the Qassim region, and is located on a total area of more than 330 thousand square meters, and can accommodate 400 beds and a capacity that can be increased to 700 beds in the future, as it consists of three main buildings and six floors linked to the building of the College of Medicine by two pedestrian bridges, and the hospital also includes 16 operating rooms, and 46 intensive care rooms equipped according to The latest international medical specifications and systems, with a separate building and an area of 14,500 square meters, and the outpatient building was established to be a tributary to the health care system in the university city, with its specialized clinics of up to 85 clinics.

The hospital also includes various clinics in the field of dentistry that have been equipped according to the latest technologies used to provide care in dental treatment, in addition to a radiology department, a sterilization department and a laboratory for installations, staffed by a group of specialists in the field and internship students in the Faculty of Dentistry, and for urgent cases, an emergency department affiliated with the university hospital has been equipped with clinics for rapid examination and detection, radiology devices and a private pharmacy, and the physiotherapy department consists of a physiotherapy department and another for occupational therapy that are equipped with 16 devices and tools Therapeutic rehabilitation, in addition to two smart gyms and a hydrotherapy swimming pool.

In addition to this, the central laboratory at the university hospital is equipped with an advanced linking system called the air carrier (PST) that connects the medical departments to the vital departments and 54 stations to receive and receive samples, in addition to the blood bank that receives volunteers, and the central pharmacy is equipped with an automated dispensing system for patients that provides a service with an error rate (0%) to provide treatment and save time and effort, thus overcoming human error.

After that, His Highness the Prince of Qassim honored the contributors to the operation of the departments in the hospital, and the ceremony was attended by His Excellency the Vice President of the University, Dr. Muhammad Al-Saawi, the Vice President for Graduate Studies and Scientific Research, Prof. Dr. Ahmed Al-Turki, the Vice President for Planning, Development and Quality, Prof.

Dr. Khaled Al-Harbi, the Vice President for Educational Affairs, Dr. Muhammad Al-Sharekh, and members of the University Council.

This agreement, which was signed on behalf of the university, by Dr. Khalid Al-Husais, CEO of the

The University Medical City Performs a Successful Operation for the Treatment of Cancerous Liver Tumor

A medical team from the Medical City of the University, represented by the Interventional Radiology Unit, was able to perform a surgery that is the first of its kind in the Qassim region, to treat a cancerous liver tumor using the chemical closure technique of the arteries supplying the tumor, where the medical team led by Dr. Abdulaziz Al-Gharras, Assistant Professor at the College of Medicine and Medical Sciences in Unaizah, Consultant Interventional Radiologist at the Medical City, succeeded in using catheterization and interventional radiology technology as a third attempt to treat it after two previous attempts to treat it in another hospital.



Where the patient was received by referral from a team specialized in gastroenterology, liver surgery and oncology from King Fahd Specialist Hospital in Buraidah, as it was found that the patient suffers from several liver tumors and his current options are limited between interventional radiology targeted treatment or intravenous chemotherapy.

The medical team in the university city reviewed with the medical team at King Fahd Specialist Hospital, and the case was discussed and appropriate treatment was provided through hepatic artery catheterization and chemotherapy directed to cancerous tumor by vascular catheterization and interventional radiology, which was done without any complications, praise be to God, which led to the patient's discharge from the hospital within a short period of the operation in health and wellness without the need for general anesthesia, severe pain or surgical incision.

For his part, Dr. Al-Gharas explained that the most important feature of catheterization operations is that they are performed through a very small opening in the thigh or wrist and with fewer complications and side effects than traditional operations with a speed of recovery.

Prof. Dr. Khaled Al-Harbi, and the deans of the concerned colleges, at the main headquarters in the university city.


