

Al-Sakka pointed out that this championship is the second and final stage of the university championship, where the first stage was held in the internal league system in each university among the college teams, through which one team was selected that includes the most prominent players in

the internal league as a university team to represent it in the final tournament held at Qassim University in the league system of one round, in which the first place holder from each group qualifies for the second round, in addition to the best two teams in the groups, where the second round matches are held in a system The exit of the defeated, while the order of the teams is determined by the total points, and each team represents 5 key players and 7 in the reserve bench, and "Al-Saqaa" confirmed that the championship matches are held in accordance with the laws of the International Federation of the game,

The opening matches of the tournament began today, where Hall (B) witnessed the match that took place between Jazan University and the University of Hail, while Hall (A) hosted the match that took place between Al-Baha University and Imam Muhammad bin Saud Islamic University.

The university team achieved the Saudi Universities Sports Federation Futsal Championship Cup, within the sixth assembly competitions of the Universities Association championships, which were held in the sports halls at the university's headquarters, under the auspices of the Minister of Education and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Federation, Dr. Ahmed Al-Issa, and with the participation of 25 universities and colleges from all over the Kingdom, where the university team repeated its achievement for the second time in



the history of the tournament, which is held for the fourth time in a row, and the Jazan University team came in second place, and Taibah University came in third place, while The University of Hail was content with fourth place in the championship.

The President of the Universities Union, Dr. Abdullah Al-Buqami, in the presence of Dr. Ali Al-Aqla, Dean of the Deanship of Student Affairs at the university, and Dr. Fahd Al-Dhalea, Vice Dean for Activities, handed over the first place cup and gold medals to the winning teams, led by the Qassim University team, which defeated the University of Hail team with a score of 6 goals to one goal in the final match that took place between them on Saturday morning at the sports hall in the university city, to be crowned champion of the fourth edition of the football championship (five-a-side), which was hosted by the university over the course of Four days from 26-29 March.

The national team players had started their training to compete in the tournament about two full months ago, after the completion of the sports activities of the university's indoor championship, which was won by the College of Education and in which 23 colleges participated, as a result of which the members of the team representing the university team were selected by the university's sports activity officials.

The results were 2-1 against King Saud University, 2-0 against um Al-Qura University, 4-0 against Shaqra University, and then the team advanced to the round of 16 to meet Mohammed Bin Fahd University and beat it 5-2, to advance to the quarter-finals and meet Prince Sattam bin Abdulaziz University team and beat it 2-0, and also beat In the semi-final match of the tournament against the

University of Hail with three goals to two, then he climbed to the final of the tournament and faced Jazan University and beat him 6-1, to win the championship cup.
