The University Medical City signed two cooperation agreements and a memorandum of understanding, with the aim of strengthening its partnership with a number of health authorities in the fields of medical studies and research and exchanging experiences, during its participation in the Global Health Forum, which was held at the Riyadh Exhibition and Convention Center, during the period from 21 to 23 October 2024.

The Medical City signed a cooperation agreement with the Saudi Health Council, with the aim of exchanging health data and information, sponsored by His Excellency the Deputy Minister of Health for Planning and Development, Eng. Abdulaziz bin Hamad Al-Rumaih, and in the presence of His Excellency the CEO of the University Hospitals Program and Secretary-General of the Council, Prof. Abdullah bin Muhammad Al-Rubaish, and signed by His Excellency the Executive Director General of the Medical City, Dr. Khalid bin Fahd Al-Husais, along with Mr. Walid bin Khalid Al-Bahili, Director General of the National Health Information Center.

The CEO of the Medical City also signed a memorandum of understanding with the University Hospital at Najran University, represented by the Director General of the hospital, Dr. Saeed Al-Qahtani, and a cooperation agreement with the Saudi Society for Health Simulation, signed by the President of the Association, Dr. Abdul Alim Al-Atassi, with the aim of enhancing cooperation in the field of medical studies and research and exchanging experiences between them.

It is noteworthy that the Medical City participated in the forum, which witnessed the participation of many local and international experts and various health institutions, through a pavilion to introduce the city's services and medical facilities, health care and training programs, and its community efforts.

The university signed a cooperation agreement with the Armed Forces Hospital in Qassim, on Sunday, September 15, 2024, signed by His Excellency the President of the University, Prof. Dr. Muhammad bin Fahd Al-Sharekh, and His Excellency the Director of the Hospital, Major General Salem bin Salem Al-Timani, in the presence of His Excellency the University Vice Rectors and Deans of Health Colleges, in the main lobby of the university city.

The agreement aims to enhance joint cooperation between the two sides in a number of fields, and build a scientific and research partnership between them in accordance with regulatory frameworks, in addition to activating communication channels at the academic and professional levels, and the agreement also aims to increase opportunities for professional practice and training for health practitioners and doctors in the health facilities of the two parties, as well as providing opportunities for internship students and undergraduate students in health colleges for practical and clinical training in the facilities of the Armed Forces Hospital in Qassim.

The terms of the agreement include cooperation in the fields of education and training in health specialties, the provision of health, advisory and administrative services, as well as the organization of workshops, seminars, conferences and joint scientific activities, in addition to cooperation in the field of scientific research, houses of expertise and possible technical resources, information sources and databases, scientific activities, exhibitions and professional meetings.
